

Genesis 20 • Abraham—A Work in Progress

1. (v.1) Abraham settles among a ruthless and wicked people under a curse from God. (Gen. 9:18-27)
2. (v.2) Abraham, from a position of fear, resorts to diluting the truth.
3. (v.3) God convicts of sin wherever it occurs.
4. (v.4-5) Sin can be an act of omission just as easily as an act of commission.
5. (v.6) God is able to read our heart, keep us from sinning against Him and able to intervene on our behalf.
6. (v.7) The one who is blessed by God is in the position of power and need have no fear.
7. (v.8-18) The one who is changed by God now has a fear of God when previously there was none.
8. (v.7 & 17) For all things to be accomplished, God required human participation through the act of prayer.
