

Leviticus 16:2-34 • Into the Holy of Holies

1. (v.2-10) Christ Himself represents:
 - a. The **High Priest** making the sacrifice, a common man without **sin**.
 - b. The **sacrifice** itself, whose blood is shed for **sin**.
 - c. The **scapegoat** for which **sins** are removed from the camp (mankind).

2. (v.11-28) Through Christ, our High Priest, all our **sins** are removed and "**sent away**".

3. (v.29-34) Coming into the presence of Christ requires both **personal** and **corporate** confession of **sin**.
